'breach of data' is the one used by the ICO:

A personal data breach means a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure of, or access to, personal data. This includes breaches that are the result of both accidental and deliberate causes. It also means that a breach is more than just about losing personal data.

This includes all internally reported data breaches, and not just those that have to be reported to the ICO.
